Setting up the unit

1. Plug in the HDMI cable - if no HDMI cable is detected the AV output will be used
2. Plug in the power and network cables
3. Wait until you see a message WAITING FOR NETWORK
4. Press the setup button on the remote control - 
5. Goto System settings 
6. To activate the Keyboard on the remote control use the button 
7. Input the portal and network settings use F2 to apply each of them
8. Press the HOME button on the remote twice
7. Choose the portal you wish
8. Press OK on the remote control

The remote control included into the package needs two AAA batteries (also included into the package*) to operate.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Your STB is not supported / Your STB is blocked
SOL: Check with your service provider
2. Nothing comes out on the screen
SOL: The HDMI port has an auto-detect function. Make sure it is plugged in when you power on the device.

Programmable Remote Control Unit

Th100 package includes a remote control with a group of five programmable buttons, marked with blue color which may be used to control other devices.

To program the buttons:

- Press and hold the blue "On/Off" and the "A/V" buttons at the same time until you notice the red light becomes brighter. This means the remote is ready to learn.
1. Choose the button you want to "teach" a new code to - the red light will start to blink.
 2. Place the infrared outputs of the two remotes against each other and press the button on the remote control of the other device that you wish to copy and hold for 2 seconds.
 3. You will see the red light blink a couple of times quickly, this means the button has been programmed.
 4. Repeat steps 1 to 3 to choose and program the other buttons of the remote control
 5. Press and hold the blue "On/Off" and the "A/V" buttons at the same time until you notice the red light turns off to save the programmed data.
